Note: the dogs eating Jezebel means that her body would be left in the elements and not given a proper burial. The same disgraceful fate was given to the family of Jeroboam (1 Kings 14:11) and Baasha (1 Kings 16:4).	Is Ahab less responsible for his sin because he has others sin on his behalf?
