Keith: Having grown up in a Christian home, I am thankful that we always went to church and that I could learn the stories of the Bible and Christian principles. At the same time, I was trying to be good and do the right things so that my parents would be proud of me. When we moved to Birmingham, I heard our new pastor speak of a personal relationship with Jesus and things made more sense to me. At age 16, I gave my heart to Jesus, and about two years later I believed that the Lord wanted me to be a missionary. I prepared for the ministry at Liberty University, where I met Dawn Smith, and we married after graduation.

Dawn: I'm so grateful to the Lord for Christian parents who loved me and took me to churches with good doctrine in the cities where we lived. When I was seven years old, my mother took my sisters and me to a Child Evangelism Good News Club where I understood for the first time that I was a sinner and that Jesus had died on the cross for my sin. That's when I asked Him to forgive me and to come into my heart and be my Savior.

Together we were church planters for 32 years with TEAM (The Evangelical Alliance Mission). We served in Bogota, Colombia, for nine years to plant a new church. After that, we planted a church in Tegucigalpa, Honduras, for the professional class. After 16 years, we asked the church in Honduras to send us to Charlotte to begin a church for those whose heart language is Spanish. Today we are striving to share the gospel each week and see a church formed that will train others and be a sending church.

### **God's power on Display to Provide Comfort to Hurting Hearts**

I am blessed to have a wonderful spiritual heritage. My parents are second generation Christians who raised my sisters and me in “the discipline and instruction of the Lord” (Eph 6:4). When I was four, I began to understand my need of salvation. One evening, while my dad was teaching a night course, my mom read the Bible with us, and I told her I wanted to get saved. As a family, we have been serving in Round Rock, Texas, as part of a church planting team at North Hills Baptist Church. When our son, Caleb, began planning to enter the military, our eyes were opened to the spiritual needs of our service men and women. God began to move in our hearts to consider military chaplaincy. I recently completed my MDiv and, Lord willing, will become an Army chaplain next year.
