

*5 Principles of Authentic Worship*

1. WORSHIP IS \_\_\_\_\_ IN NATURE. (JOHN 4:24; GALATIANS 5:17; JOHN 6:63; ROMANS 7:18; GALATIANS 2:20)

Four Observations. (Galatians 2:20)

- I am dead, yet I \_\_\_\_\_.
- Though I live, it is not me — \_\_\_\_\_ lives in me.
- I live this life in the flesh (which is dead) by \_\_\_\_\_.
- It is this life from which our worship comes forth.

2. WORSHIP IS INTENSELY \_\_\_\_\_.

Authentic worship takes place in the private chambers of a heart that is properly prepared to worship.

3. WORSHIP REQUIRES SACRIFICE.
