Key Terms and People

Ahaziah: Eighth king of the Northern Kingdom of Israel. Reigned 853–852 B.C.

Elijah: Prophet of God from Tishbe. His name means "My God is Yahweh."

Baal-Zebub: A name for Baal that means "Lord of the Flies," "Lord of Shame," or "Exalted Lord." The Philistines of Ekron worshipped many different gods, including this one.

Angel of the LORD: Either an angel from the Lord or the Angel of the LORD, often identified as a preincarnate Christ. He speaks for Yahweh and directs Elijah's ministry.
